Dear Balboa Park Museum or Organization:

This notice is to inform you that the 25th Annual AIDS WALK/RUN San Diego event will be held on **Saturday, September 27th, 2014** and will pass through beautiful Balboa Park and the surrounding areas. As you are a business in or around the park, we want to bring this to your attention as street closures and other activities might impact your normal Saturday routine.

There will be several street closings and no parking areas in the community.

**Street closures that will affect traffic within and around Balboa Park:**

**The official time of street closure will be from 7:00AM to 1:00PM.**

**Within the Park (this section should be open by 10AM)**

- Plaza de Panama and El Prado from Presidents Way to 6<sup>th</sup> Ave. (Presidents Way up to Plaza de Panama will most likely be open before 9:15am because only the runners use this).
- Village Place from Park Blvd to El Prado.

**West Side of the Park (should be open by 10:30AM)**

- Balboa Drive between Quince and Juniper and through Marston Point
- Sixth Ave Northbound between Elm and University Ave.
- Sixth Ave Southbound from University Ave to Upas and again from Laurel to Elm
- Juniper between 6<sup>th</sup> Ave and Balboa Dr.
- University Ave Eastbound from 6<sup>th</sup> Ave to Park Blvd and Westbound from Park to Richmond
- Quince freeway exit

**East Side of the Park (should be open by 9:30AM)**

- Park Blvd between University Ave and Presidents Way
- Village Place
- Sixth Ave Northbound between Elm and University Ave

The streets will not be closed this entire time but this gives you the longest possibilities. **There will be no parking posted from 4 AM until 1 PM on the following streets: Balboa Drive from Quince to Juniper and through Marston Point, 6<sup>th</sup> Ave from Elm to University, Eastbound University from 6<sup>th</sup> Ave to Richmond Street. Both sides of University Ave from Richmond St to Park Blvd,**

Please note that **the city authorizes towing to begin at 4:00am** on the streets listed above. Please communicate to your patrons that they should not park on above streets during the times shown. Parked cars will be towed at the owner's expense. Once the streets are open we will pick up the no parking signs so there isn't any confusion.

The westbound lanes of University Ave. will remain open from Richmond to 6th.
